trebia trasimene cannae with three stunning victories hannibal humbled rome and nearly shattered its empire even today hannibal s brilliant if ultimately unsuccessful campaign against rome during the second punic war 218 202 bc make him one of history s most celebrated military leaders this biography by cornelius nepos c 100 27 bc sketches hannibal s life from the time he began traveling with his father s army as a young boy through his sixteen year invasion of italy and his tumultuous political career in carthage to his perilous exile and eventual suicide in the east as rome completed its bloody transition from dysfunctional republic to stable monarchy nepos labored to complete an innovative and influential collection of concise biographies putting aside the detailed chronological accounts of military campaigns and political machinations that characterized most writing about history nepos surveyed roman and greek history for distinguished men who excelled in a range of prestigious occupations in the exploits and achievements of these illustrious men nepos hoped that his readers would find models for the honorable conduct of their own lives although most of nepos works have been lost we are fortunate to have his biography of hannibal nepos offers a surprisingly balanced portrayal of a man that most roman authors vilified as the most monstrous foe that rome had ever faced nepos straightforward style and his preference for common vocabulary make life of hannibal accessible for those who are just beginning to read continuous latin prose while the historical interest of the subject make it compelling for readers of every ability

this extract from ovid s theban history recounts the confrontation of pentheus king of thebes with his divine cousin bacchus the god of wine notwithstanding the warnings of the seer tiresias and the cautionary tale of a character acoetes perhaps bacchus in disguise who tells of how the god once transformed a group of blasphemous sailors into dolphins pentheus refuses to acknowledge the divinity of bacchus or allow his worship at thebes enraged yet curious to witness the orgiastic rites of the nascent cult pentheus conceals himself in a grove on mt cithaeron near the locus of the ceremonies but in the course of the rites he is spotted by the female participants who rush upon him in a delusional frenzy his mother and sisters in the vanguard and tear him limb from limb the episode abounds in themes of abiding

interest not least the clash between the authoritarian personality of pentheus who embodies law and order masculine prowess and the martial ethos of his city and bacchus a somewhat effeminate god of orgiastic excess who revels in the delusional and the deceptive the transgression of boundaries and the blurring of gender distinctions this course book offers a wide ranging introduction the original latin text study aids with vocabulary and an extensive commentary designed to stretch and stimulate readers gildenhard and zissos s incisive commentary will be of particular interest to students of latin at as and undergraduate level it extends beyond detailed linguistic analysis to encourage critical engagement with ovid s poetry and discussion of the most recent scholarly thought

cicero composed his incendiary philippics only a few months after rome was rocked by the brutal assassination of julius caesar in the tumultuous aftermath of caesar s death cicero and mark antony found themselves on opposing sides of an increasingly bitter and dangerous battle for control philippic 2 was a weapon in that war conceived as cicero s response to a verbal attack from antony in the senate philippic 2 is a rhetorical firework that ranges from abusive references to antony s supposedly sordid sex life to a sustained critique of what cicero saw as antony s tyrannical ambitions vituperatively brilliant and politically committed it is both a carefully crafted literary artefact and an explosive example of crisis rhetoric it ultimately led to cicero s own gruesome death this course book offers a portion of the original latin text vocabulary aids study questions and an extensive commentary designed to stretch and stimulate readers ingo gildenhard s volume will be of particular interest to students of latin studying for a level or on undergraduate courses it extends beyond detailed linguistic analysis to encourage critical engagement with cicero his oratory the politics of late republican rome and the transhistorical import of cicero s politics of verbal and physical violence
