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timber the old raw material and building material returns there are many reasons today for building with wood and there are great advantages over conventional designs wood is not only a renewable building material that helps reduce the levels of co2 and is hence good for climate change but due to modern computing and manufacturing processes it can also be used for a variety of construction tasks wood possesses excellent qualities for both construction and indoor climate control and can easily be combined with other common building materials based on 24 international projects the book provides an overview of the range of possibilities in wood construction today texts images and plans document the architectural and constructive qualities of contemporary timber structures from the conceptual

design to the structure in detail the various uses are based on current research in modern timber engineering but also on timber construction expertise that has been developing over many centuries this special discipline has evolved significantly in recent decades particularly in germany austria and switzerland and is a world leader today

many books have covered the topics of architecture materials and technology new architecture and technology is the first to explore the interrelation between these three subjects it illustrates the impact of modern technology and materials on architecture the book explores the technical progress of building showing how developments both past and present are influenced by design methods it provides a survey of contemporary architecture as affected by construction technology it also explores aspects of building technology within the context of general industrial social and economic developments the reader will acquire a vocabulary covering the entire range of structure types and learn a new approach to understanding the development of design

the geographic region around the north pole is a raw and exotic area of untouched nature and inescapable beauty building in this extremely cold climate requires an advanced degree of ingenuity and resolve ecological conditions including high winds snowdrifts and permafrost combined with periods of little sunlight present seemingly impossible logistical hurdles for architects vernacular buildings have emerged but like most indigenous structures they do little more than simply enclose and protect recent years have witnessed an explosion of exceptional new architecture and a new definition of a northern building one that is both extraordinarily responsive to place and aesthetically provocative in modern north architecture on the frozen edge author julie decker presents thirty four of the most compelling and far ranging possibilities of contemporary architecture in the north these buildings located in northern canada scandinavia and alaska are united in the way they embrace extreme conditions and provide visual stimulation in places that sometimes offer little more than a whitescape the book contains innovative structures by both established and up and coming architects including david chipperfield architects studio granda and shim sutcliffe architects as well as essays by brian carter juhani pallasmaa edwin crittenden and lisa rochon that place the projects in the context of a new architectural response to the north book jacket

originally published in french as a series of essays in the magazine l esprit nouveau revue beginning in 1921 towards a new architecture by le corbusier was published as a book in 1923 and first translated into english in 1927 le corbusier s revolutionary approach to architecture became an instant classic and a highly influential work on the meaning and function of buildings and cities in the modern age born in switzerland as charles edouard jeanneret in 1887 le corbusier became a world renowned architect in towards a new architecture he expands upon and clarifies his guiding design principles specifically that buildings should serve modern needs and that form should be pure le corbusier rejected much of classical and art deco design as valuing stylistic experimentation and expression over function his dramatically different ideas of using materials and design to change the relationship of people with their surroundings completely transformed modern architecture and city planning and remain relevant and informative to this day towards a new architecture is a must
